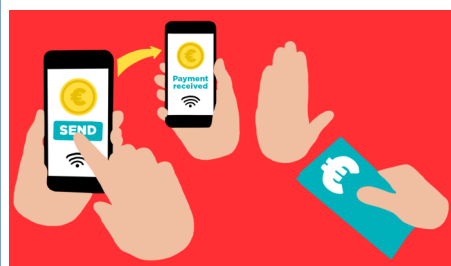
### Your Stats

65% of families are using the mobile app

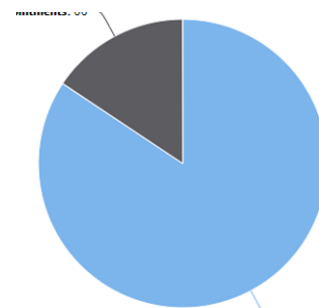


We would really like to go completely cashless as a school so please watch out for the **deadline date** which we are yet to set. If you have any concerns over this please can you contact us to discuss the option around this.

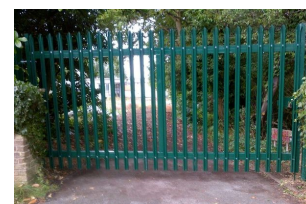
## A warm welcome to Springfield

## Gate opening at Springfield

We are making slight alterations to our school day from after half term so that **all** children are safe when they are on school site. If your child swears the consequences are set that they will receive a warning the first time. Then in the unlikely event that it happens again they will pick the phone up to their parent/carer and repeat the word or phrase to you.

We have a zero tolerance of any physical acts of violence toward children/adults or school property. If this should happen there will be serious consequences and parents will be contacted immediately.
